Radon is a naturally forming odourless, colourless radioactive gas that seeps up through natural fissures in the ground. In geographical areas of higher radon presence, there is a small risk of radon collecting within modern buildings, giving rise to potential health risks.

Cottsway's aim as a Landlord is to identify properties with higher than normal radon levels, and to take action as appropriate.

We are offering **free radon tests** to residents in some geographical areas where we have identified particular risks.

Cottsway's programme of radon identification and control is a precautionary measure to meet recent guidelines and to minimise risks. Actual health issues due to high radon levels are rare and require a life-time of exposure.
